Should any selected player be unavailable to play and notify the respective convener of selectors of their unavailability, the selectors shall nominate a replacement.

If a chosen player who arrives at the Tournament venue on the due date and through some circumstances does not commence the first game of the tournament, the reserve, nominated by the selectors, shall play and the replaced player shall become the reserve. If a player during the tournament has to be replaced with the reserve and the reserve plays more games than the original player, then the reserve shall prevail.

The players in each section shall play five games amongst themselves on a league basis. The Executive reserves the right to curtail the number of rounds in the event of inclement weather conditions and determine section winners on a lesser number of rounds. The winner of each section shall be the player with the highest number of points and in the event of two or more players having an equal number of points, the winner will be determined by nett score. Should there still be a tie then the winner of the game between the two players during round robin play will be the section winner.

For all matches the winner shall be the first player to attain twenty-one shots, or as determined by the Executive from time to time.

The winners and runners-up of each section will qualify for play in the Open Masters.

Restrictions on movement during play: Players may only go to the head after delivery of their third bowl unless permission is given by the marker after their second bowl is delivered.

Teas and green fees will be paid for by Port Natal Bowls. Lunches will be for the players' account.

Players are expected to report by 8.30 a.m. on both days – for play to commence at 9.00 a.m. Three games to be played on Saturday 26th June and two games on Sunday 27th June 2010.
