

PORT NATAL BOWLS

2022 PRO10 PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship will be played on a **Round Robin** basis on the following days at the greens indicated in the draw, commencing at the times shown below.

Rounds 1 – 5	SUNDAY – 09/01/2022 at 08h30 – Round Robin – 10 ends
Playoffs to Final	SUNDAY – 16/01/2022 at 08h30 – Knock Out
Standby Date	SUNDAY – 23/01/2022

Last call is at 08h15 and play to commence at 08h30. Players failing to respond to the final call will be scratched.

The venue for the Playoffs to Final will be **AMANZIMTOTI BC**.

Green fees – R20.00 per person for the day (Round Robin) then from the knock out stages players will pay R5.00 per person per round. Two bowl pairs played over 10 ends throughout this competition. Only one trial end may be played at the commencement of a game. Tea and eats for Sunday morning games. Clubs to provide light lunches for all day games. There must be an umpire on duty and the name must be announced prior to commencement of play. Cellphones and Smoking will not be permitted within 2 meters of the green while play is in progress. Umbrellas are permitted on the banks only. Both players in a team need to be First Call members of a club. Consumption of Alcohol during play is NOT permitted.

Participants are requested to wear bright coloured clothes or their Club Colours for the duration of this tournament, subject to both members of the team being uniformly dressed.

The scoring system shall be ten points per end and made up as follows:-

Nearest to the jack – 4 points; second shot – 3 points; third shot – 2 points; fourth shot – 1 point. The team with the bowl nearest the jack at the conclusion of an end will start the next end. In a “no shot” situation the bowl nearest the jack in the previous end shall start the following end. 2 points for a win and 1 point for a peel. The winner will be the team with the most number of points. In the event of a tie then the team with the most number of points for will be declared the winner. Should there still be a tie, then the team having won their game against each other will be declared the winner. Dead ends or a jack being declared dead, the end is to be replayed. In the event of a peeled game in the knock out stages then an extra end must be played. Please note that games are played in the same direction all day during the Round Robin games.
