

Hi Everyone

Please pass on a copy of this mail to the clubs under your control. Upon receipt of the Government Gazette setting out details around the lockdown we posed the question of greens maintenance to Thomas Minnie, our legal advisor, herewith his response:

100% the maintenance of sporting facilities is allowed.

I would thus suggest the person(s) who are going to do the maintenance obtain a letter on the clubs letter head; stipulating all their ID details; as well as an explanation of the schedule which will be followed, which they can produce if stopped. My humble opinion is that during this time, once a week will suffice. Watering may depend on the temperature and climatic conditions, so that should also be factored in.

REMEMBER though, the other provisions still apply. So, there may not be more than 2 persons from different households at the premises in close proximity.

The following should be included in the letter on the clubs letterhead.

In term paragraph 11 D(4) OF THE Government proclamation permission is granted to the person/s set out hereunder to attend to maintenance at the facility below:
